Before joining the firm, Aubrey worked for a class action law firm in Chicago where she drafted many pretrial litigation documents involving claims such as negligence, breach of contract, the Illinois Biometric Information Privacy Act, the Illinois Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act, and the Telephone Consumer Protection Act. She also worked for a medical malpractice defense firm in Chicago and worked for the General Counsel team for the Governor of Illinois. Before attending law school, she worked at an immigration law firm in Chicago where she drafted and filed various immigration petitions for foreign nationals who were sponsored by corporate employers.

Aubrey earned her Juris Doctor from the University of Illinois College of Law, where she earned her pro bono notation award and was a student leader for the Illinois Supreme Court Commission on Access to Justice. She served as the Treasurer of the College of Law's Corporate and Business Law Association. Aubrey was also a student attorney in the College of Law's Intellectual Property-Trademark Clinic, where she counseled startup companies on the trademark application process.

She earned her bachelor's degree with a double major in Political Science and Criminal Justice from Western Michigan University. During her time there, she was a four-year member of the varsity soccer team and earned the role of captain her senior year. She was a MAC Tournament Champion in 2013, received an All-MAC (2nd Team) award in 2013 and made the Academic All-MAC team in 2013 and 2014. Aubrey was nominated for NCAA Woman of the Year in 2015, which honors the academic achievements, athletic excellence, community service and leadership of graduating female college athletes.
